

## 52 Great Verses of the Bible – Weekly List

*September 11* – John 3:16-17

<sup>16</sup> ‘For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life. <sup>17</sup> ‘Indeed, God did not send the Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.

*September 18* – Genesis 1:1-3

<sup>1</sup>In the beginning when God created the heavens and the earth, <sup>2</sup>the earth was a formless void and darkness covered the face of the deep, while a wind from God swept over the face of the waters. <sup>3</sup>Then God said, ‘Let there be light’; and there was light.

*September 25* – Matthew 28:19

<sup>19</sup>Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

*October 2* – Romans 5:6-8

<sup>6</sup> For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. <sup>7</sup>Indeed, rarely will anyone die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person someone might actually dare to die. <sup>8</sup>But God proves his love for us in that while we still were sinners Christ died for us.

*October 9* – Ephesians 2:8

<sup>8</sup>For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God—

*October 16* – John 14:6

<sup>6</sup>Jesus said to him, ‘I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

*October 23*– Isaiah 52:7

<sup>7</sup> How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of the messenger who announces peace, who brings good news, who announces salvation, who says to Zion, ‘Your God reigns.’

*October 30* – 2 Corinthians 4:7

<sup>7</sup> But we have this treasure in clay jars, so that it may be made clear that this extraordinary power belongs to God and does not come from us.

*November 6* — Romans 3:28

<sup>28</sup>For we hold that a person is justified by faith apart from works prescribed by the law.

*November 13* — John 1:14

<sup>14</sup> And the Word became flesh and lived among us, and we have seen his glory, the glory as of a father’s only son, full of grace and truth.

*November 20* — Galatians 5:22

<sup>22</sup> By contrast, the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness.

*November 27*— Jeremiah 29:11

<sup>11</sup>For surely I know the plans I have for you, says the LORD, plans for your welfare and not for harm, to give you a future with hope.

*December 4* — John 14:1-2

<sup>1</sup> Do not let your hearts be troubled. Believe in God, believe also in me. <sup>2</sup> In my Father's house there are many dwelling-places. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you?

*December 11* – Isaiah 9:2

<sup>2</sup> The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who lived in a land of deep darkness—on them light has shined.

*December 18* — Romans 8:28

<sup>28</sup> We know that all things work together for good for those who love God, who are called according to his purpose.

*December 25* — Isaiah 9:6

<sup>6</sup> For a child has been born for us, a son given to us; authority rests upon his shoulders; and he is named Wonderful Counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

*January 1*— John 1:1

<sup>1</sup> In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

*January 8* — Amos 5:24

<sup>24</sup> But let justice roll down like waters, and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream.

*January 15* — Matthew 2:1-2

<sup>1</sup>In the time of King Herod, after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem, <sup>2</sup>asking, 'Where is the child who has been born king of the Jews? For we observed his star at its rising, and have come to pay him homage.'

*January 22* – Matthew 11:28-30

<sup>28</sup> 'Come to me, all you that are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. <sup>29</sup>Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. <sup>30</sup>For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.'

*January 29* – Romans 6:23

<sup>23</sup>For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

*February 5* – 2 Corinthians 5:17

<sup>17</sup>So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation: everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new!

*February 12* – John 13:34-35

<sup>34</sup>I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another. <sup>35</sup>By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.'

*February 19* – Philippians 4:13

<sup>13</sup>I can do all things through him who strengthens me.

*February 26* – Genesis 2:1-3

<sup>1</sup>Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all their multitude. <sup>2</sup>And on the seventh day God finished the work that he had done, and he rested on the seventh day from all the work that he had done. <sup>3</sup>So God blessed the seventh day and hallowed it, because on it God rested from all the work that he had done in creation.

*March 4* – Galatians 3:28

<sup>28</sup>There is no longer Jew or Greek, there is no longer slave or free, there is no longer male and female; for all of you are one in Christ Jesus.

*March 11* – Genesis 12:1-3

<sup>1</sup>Now the LORD said to Abram, 'Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you. <sup>2</sup>I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you, and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. <sup>3</sup>I will bless those who bless you, and the one who curses you I will curse; and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.'

*March 18* – Joshua 24:15

<sup>15</sup>Now if you are unwilling to serve the LORD, choose this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your ancestors served in the region beyond the River or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you are living; but as for me and my household, we will serve the LORD.'

*March 25* – Exodus 15:2

<sup>2</sup> The LORD is my strength and my might, and he has become my salvation; this is my God, and I will praise him, my father's God, and I will exalt him.

*April 1* – Exodus 3:11-12

<sup>11</sup>But Moses said to God, 'Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh, and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?' <sup>12</sup>He said, 'I will be with you; and this shall be the sign for you that it is I who sent you: when you have brought the people out of Egypt, you shall worship God on this mountain.'

*April 8* – Psalm 121:1-2

<sup>1</sup> I lift up my eyes to the hills—from where will my help come? <sup>2</sup> My help comes from the LORD, who made heaven and earth.

*April 15* – Micah 6:8

<sup>8</sup> He has told you, O mortal, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?

*April 22* – Isaiah 6:8

<sup>8</sup>Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, 'Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?' And I said, 'Here am I; send me!'

*April 29* – Matthew 28:5-6

<sup>5</sup>But the angel said to the women, 'Do not be afraid; I know that you are looking for Jesus who was crucified. <sup>6</sup>He is not here; for he has been raised, as he said. Come, see the place where he lay.

*May 6* – Isaiah 43:1

<sup>1</sup> But now thus says the LORD, he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel: Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are mine.

*May 13 – Romans 12:1*

<sup>1</sup> I appeal to you therefore, brothers and sisters, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.

*May 20 – Isaiah 25:1*

<sup>1</sup> O LORD, you are my God; I will exalt you, I will praise your name; for you have done wonderful things, plans formed of old, faithful and sure.

*May 27 – Psalm 46:1*

<sup>1</sup> To the leader. Of the Korahites. According to Alamoth. A Song. <sup>1</sup> God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

*June 3 – John 8:31-32*

<sup>31</sup> Then Jesus said to the Jews who had believed in him, 'If you continue in my word, you are truly my disciples; <sup>32</sup>and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free.'

*June 10— Psalm 103:1*

<sup>1</sup> Bless the LORD, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless his holy name.

*June 17 — Acts 1:8*

<sup>8</sup>But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.'

*June 24 — Luke 4:18-19*

<sup>18</sup> 'The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, <sup>19</sup> to proclaim the year of the Lord's favour.'

*July 1 – 1 Corinthians 1:18*

<sup>18</sup> For the message about the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

*July 8 – Psalm 118:1*

<sup>1</sup> O give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his steadfast love endures forever!

*July 15 – Philippians 4:4*

<sup>4</sup> Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, Rejoice.

*July 22– Joel 2:28-29*

<sup>28</sup> Then afterwards I will pour out my spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, and your young men shall see visions. <sup>29</sup> Even on the male and female slaves, in those days, I will pour out my spirit.

*July 29 – Romans 12:2*

<sup>2</sup> Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your minds, so that you may discern what is the will of God—what is good and acceptable and perfect.

*August 5 – Psalm 46:10a*

<sup>10</sup> 'Be still, and know that I am God! I am exalted among the nations, I am exalted in the earth.'

*August 12* – Genesis 9:12-13

<sup>12</sup> God said, 'This is the sign of the covenant that I make between me and you and every living creature that is with you, for all future generations: <sup>13</sup>I have set my bow in the clouds, and it shall be a sign of the covenant between me and the earth.

*August 19* – Psalm 118:24

<sup>24</sup> This is the day that the LORD has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.

*August 26*– Philippians 4:6-7

<sup>6</sup> Do not worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. <sup>7</sup>And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

*September 2*– Hebrews 11:1

<sup>1</sup> Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.
